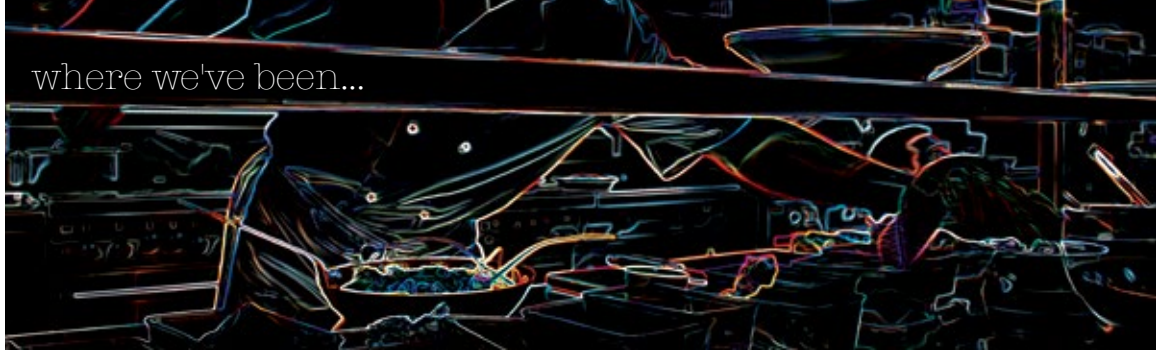


where we've been...



WILD DRAGONFLY Mount Annan

My PA, Kirsty (I know it's confusing), has been raving about breakfast at Wild Dragonfly Cafe for a while. It's one of her favourite places to take her mummy friends and their kids. Kirsty told me the food is great and you can dine inside or out while the kids are entertained on play equipment next to the verandah. The surrounds of the garden centre make for a pretty outlook from every direction. Oh yes, Wild Dragonfly is hidden away inside Flower Power at Mount Annan.

Although things are improving quickly, breakfast and lunch spots around Campbelltown are not in abundance. Located a few minutes up Narellan Road, Wild Dragonfly offers a lovely setting and very nice food. I recently arranged a lunch meeting there to discuss the 2017 AnnanRoma festival.

We arrived to find Wild Dragonfly 'as advertised' by Kirsty. My dining partners were Jo from Pretty Picnics and Rebecca from The Australian Botanic Garden. I know both these girls very well, so it was a pleasant catch up as much as a meeting.

Jo has already eaten so it was just Bec and I. We went inside to grab a menu and order. Bec went for Sweet Potato, Rocquette and Fetta Salad - a very healthy choice. Mine was reasonably healthy too - The Dragonfly Toastie: Grilled Cajun Chicken, Roasted Sweet Potato, Brie, Spanish Onion and Basil Pesto Dressing.

Our simple, fresh and well thought out meals were great. Perfectly appropriate for the

environment projected by the cute little cafe. A lovely brecky or lunch spot.
