


where we've been...

We felt like VIP's.

We got the half serve of cheesy fries, which turned out to be large. The full serve must be huge. We also got salad with the ribs instead of more fries.

All of the food was great. I know you're probably judging us about the cheesy fries (I know my Dad is) but wow they were good. And you know what? I'd definitely order them again next time.

I also feel like I need to mention that they have beers on tap. This doesn't really mean much to me but Josh mentioned it several times so this may appeal to some people? He even went as far to say that he would like to go there just for a cold beer.
