I made my own salad from all of the different options at the salad bar. Sizzler do have a number of yummy looking salads made up by their chefs. There are tempting treats like spiced lamb and apricot cous cous, and Mediterranean pesto salad. I do like being able

to create my own salad though - with exactly what I desire (control freak Ed.). Sizzler have a huge variety of salad selections to choose from. I piled my plate with baby spinach, cap-sicum, sun-dried tomatoes, cucumber, carrot, broccoli, olives and a sprinkle or shaved Parmesan. Everything was very fresh.
