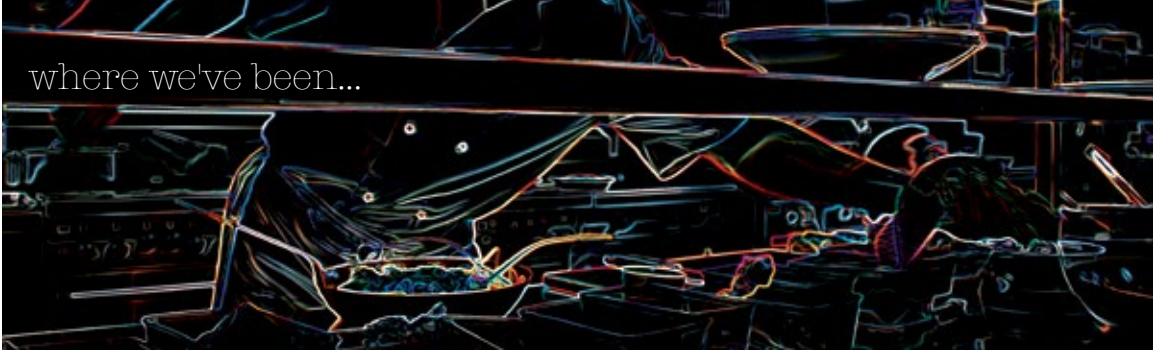

I visited this new Lebanese takeaway/restaurant at The Podium Centre, Oran Park recently with my son Chad. A morning working for his Dad had earned my youngest son lunch and this was a yum lunch.

It's a cool, small space, catering mostly to takeaway. It is a vast improvement on the previous business that existed in the space. They too did Lebanese food but their intent was much more low key. Two Chicks replaces it with a stylish fit out and more seating.

I wrote about the previous Lebanese takeaway once in the magazine and one of my daughter's friends thought it sounded so good that she would book a table. Only one of the namesake 'chicks' was on hand for our visit. Lynda is lovely and we had an extended chat while ordering. Chad opted for a Chilli Chicken Wrap while I went for a Lamb Kofta Plate with Babaghanoush, Tabouli, Lebanese Rice and Bread and Mixed Pickles. We both loved our meals. Lamb Kofta is one of my favourites and this example was a beauty. Unless you're a big eater, go easy. The Lebanese rice and bread takes up a lot of space.

The sisters (Two Chicks) are from a local farming family so the produce is second to none and the recipes are largely famous
